Who can choose Movin' Out?

Community members who would like to be a live-in support provider for other community members with developmental disabilities.

and

Medicaid eligible individuals who want to live in their own house or apartment and would like to receive supports from a live-in provider.

An individual who takes part in Movin ' Out chooses who he or she lives with. This could be someone they already know or a community member who has let Allegany Arc know they are interested in being a provider.

Movin ' Out is a program rooted in the understanding that a community is not whole without all of its members being able to take part as active citizens to the extent that he or she chooses.

Who Can Choose Shared Living?

Individuals who would like to move from their current living situation to a home of their choice. People who decide to do Shared Living can either rent or buy an apartment or house; have a roommate or live alone. Whether living alone or with a roommate, individuals taking part in Shared Living can receive support from outside of the home like the Paid Neighbor service or Community Habilitation services. These services give individuals the support they want while living independently in the community.

The Choice Is Yours!

Individuals interested in buying a home may be eligible for financing options offered through OPWDD ' s Home of Your Own program. For information ask your MSC or call OPWDD ' s Housing Initiatives at 518-473-1973

Help wanted!

Shared Living and Movin ' Out offer an opportunity for community members to take part in the lives of other community members who have developmental disabilities. Both of these programs offer support to the individuals receiving services. What we need are community members who would like to provide this support. The time commitment ranges from a few hours a week to being a live-in support. Whatever best fits the provider ' s lifestyle. All providers will be compensated for the work they do. An expectation of support providers is that they are motivated to work alongside the individual who they are working with and believe that the value of the experience goes beyond monetary compensation.
